# **CALENDAR FOR 2012-2013**

## A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

The College was founded during the year 1955 -56 and housed in the Govt. High School, Komarapalayam. It was affiliated to the University of Madras. Originally, it offered B.Ed Degree course and the Pandit Training Course. The College started functioning in the present buildings situated in an area of about 19 acres from 5.3.72 onwards. The M.Ed., Degree Course was started as an evening course during the year 1974 - 1975. In October 1976 the Pandit Training Course was wound up and in the year 1982 -83 M.Ed., Degree Course was converted into a full time course. The college became a co-education institution during the year 1990 - 91.

A permanent hostel building for men students was opened in 1986-87 and for women students during the year 1993-94. The sanctioned strength for B.Ed. increased to 100 with an additional strength of 20 seats sanctioned exclusively to accommodate B.Lit. candidates during the academic year 1998 - 99. The college is affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai from 2008 - 2009.

#### 1. PRACTICE TEACHING AND OBSERVATION

Students will be trained by the senior teacher in various Govt. Hr. Sec. Schools. During this period students must plan and teach lessons to high/higher secondary school pupils in their optional subjects. They should also plan and administer achievement tests, in the optional subject. All relevant records must be submitted to the teacher educator concerned before the date of completion of teaching practice. The students will also participate in all the activities of practice teaching schools during their teaching practice.

#### 2. PHYSICAL EDUCATOIN

The College has play ground with facilities for outdoor games. The students are expected to participate in and organize physical education activities as an essential part of their practical.

3. THE COLLEGE LIBRARY 14470

The library contains 19,968 books on various titles pertaining to B.Ed. M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. courses. Magazines and Journals of educational interest are available for both Students and Teachers.

#### 4. COLLEGE UNION

The aim of the college union is to study and discuss subjects of professional and general interest. All the students are members of the college union. The Principal is the President of the Union. The work of the Union will be managed by a committee consisting of (i) The President (ii) Vice-President

(iii) Student leader and (iv) Student Secretaries. Student leader and Student Secretaries will be elected by Students. An Editorial Board supervises the Publication of the College Magazine every year.

## 5. CITIZENSHIP TRAINING CAMP

5 days Citizenship Training Camp is compulsory for all the B.Ed., Students. It is conducted every year which help them to develop an integrated personality. In this camp, Students exhibit their talents such as Dance, Singing, Mimicry, Mime, etc.

#### 6. PLACEMENT CELL

The placement cell of Govt. College of Education provides valuable service to their Trainees by arranging for campus interviews and reference service to the Schools in and around Komarapalayam. Also this cell conducts Personality Development Programmes.

#### 7. FEE CONCESSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

#### Fee Concessions - 92 T.N.E.R.

Students belonging to SC & ST (including converts) are eligible for award of full fee concession if they produce a Community Certificate from Tahsildar.

#### Adi Dravida Welfare Scholarships

Adi Dravida Welfare Scholarships of the Tamil Nadu State Government are granted as per Government norms.

## Backward Class Scholarships

Residential and Non Residential Scholarships for the B.C., MBC and DNC students sanctioned by the Backward class Department of the TamilNadu State Government are granted as per Government norms.

# Farmers Welfare Security Scheme

Children of Farmers are eligible to apply this scholarship.

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## TUTORIAL SYSTEM

 For the purpose of effective guidance and supervision, all student teachers will be under the supervision of the members of the staff, whose advices students may seek on

- matters relating to their studies and other activities in and out of the college.
- 2. Student teachers are divided into different tutorial groups. Each student is expected to see her tutor periodically atleast once a month or at such a time as may be fixed by the tutor and give a report of what has been done by her during the period and get her advice on all matters concerned with the activities of the college.
- 3. Tutorial meetings will be conducted once a fortnight by each tutor for guiding the students on matters of academic and general interest.
- 4. Leave application should always be submitted to the Principal through the tutors concerned. Leave will be sanctioned by the Principal on recommendation of the tutor. Students are not permitted to absent themselves without leave. In case where absence without leave in unavoidable circumstance, application for leave must be submitted as soon as possible and in no case later than the first day of return to college.
- 5. If a student is absent for five consecutive working days without applying for leave, her name will ordinarily be removed from the rolls of the college.
- 6. Where leave is applied for owing to sickness, the production of a certificate by a registered medical practitioner is compulsory.
- 7. The necessary attendance certificate will not be granted unless the Principal is satisfied that the student's progress and conduct have been satisfactory.
- 8. A student may be dismissed for serious misconduct and if so dismissed, she may be declared unfit for employment as teacher.
- 9. Students are strictly forbidden to organize unauthorized meeting in the College, or collect money for any purpose without the permission of the principal
- 10. No notice of any kind shall be circulated among students or displayed on the notice board, without the previous sanction of the Principal.
- 11. In all matters affecting the reputation of the College, students must conduct themselves with dignity and decorum.

- 12. Under the Tamil Nadu Government Education Rules the Principal is empowered to take any action deemed necessary from time to time.
- 13. Difficulties experienced by the students and suggestions for improving their welfare may be brought to the notice of the Principal or any other staff members for consideration and necessary action. Students can appeal to the Grievance and Appeal Committee.
- 14. Students violating any of the above rules shall be severely dealt with.
- 15. Literary Associations of Tamil and English and clubs of Mathematics, Physical Science, Biological Science and History function actively.
- 16. Eco friendly Club insists environmental awareness among the students.
- 17. Guidance and Counseling Cell, Placement Cell and Library Advisory Council also function actively throughout the year.

#### **LIBRARY**

- I. The Library is under the direct control of Principal and the Librarian.
- II. All students of the College, Teachers, Clerical Staff and other Officials of the College are entitled to use the Library.
- III. The Library shall be open on all working days from 09.00 a.m. to 05.00 p.m.
- IV. SILENCE shall be strictly observed in the Library.
- V. 1. Each student shall borrow 5 book at a time once a week.
- 2. Students shall be responsible for all books borrowed by them on borrower's tickets.
- 3. A student who has lost a book shall make a written report of the same to the Librarian.
- 4. Students and staff should not carry any book or any printed matter into the Library and they shall leave their own books in the room provided for that purpose near the Library.

- 5. Students shall not write upon, damage or make any mark upon any book, periodical, manuscript or map belonging to the library. If a book is damaged, or lost, the person shall be held responsible to replace it by a new copy.
  - 6. No tracing or mechanical reproduction shall be made without permission from the librarian.
  - 7. Students are not allowed to sub-lend the books of the library to any person in any circumstance.
  - VI. 1. Students will be entitled to keep a book for seven days from the date of issue. At the end of the period the book shall be returned to the library.
  - 2. A student failing to return the book after 7 days from the date of issue will be fined Rs.1/- for each day of delay for every book.
  - 3. Books falling due on holidays may be returned on the next working day.
  - 4. A student may get the same book renewed for a period of another 7 days provided it has not in the meantime been applied for by another student.
  - 5. Any book may be recalled by the Librarian at any time at her discretion.
  - VII. 1. All the members of the staff and students have open access to the shelves.
  - 2. The total number of books on loan with the members of the staff at any time shall not exceed generally ten volumes.
  - 3. Encyclopaedias, dictionaries and books which might be difficult to replace and be considered necessary for reference shall not be lent out.
  - 4. Periodicals are issued on loan only to members of the staff. Current periodicals may be taken out of the Library only during such hours as the Library is closed.
  - 5. There is a Book Bank in the library to tend text books to the needy and deserving students.
  - 6. All books should be returned to the library by staff members & students at the end of the year.
